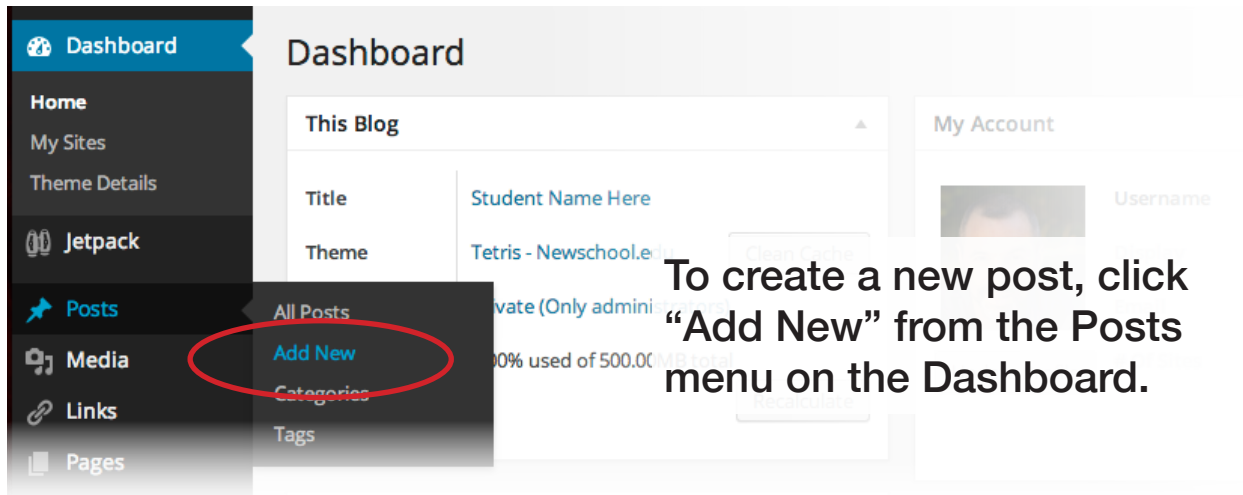


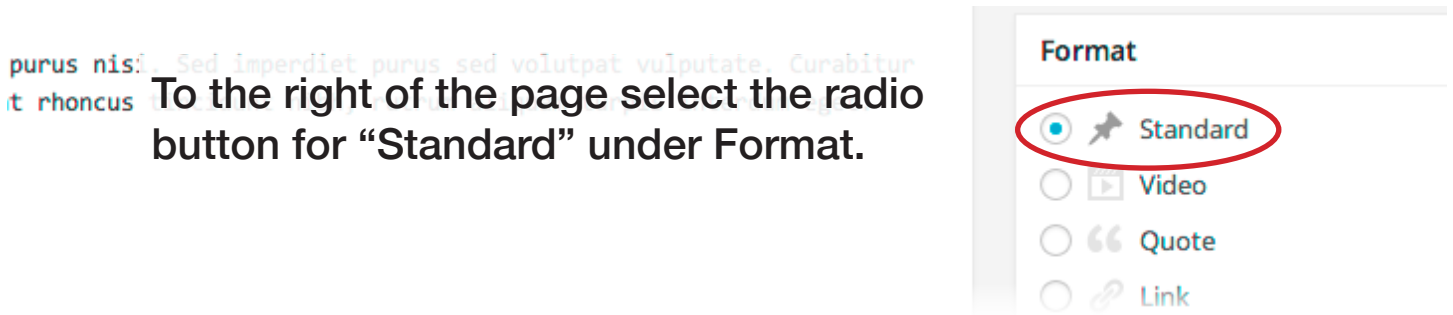
# Embed A PDF In A Post

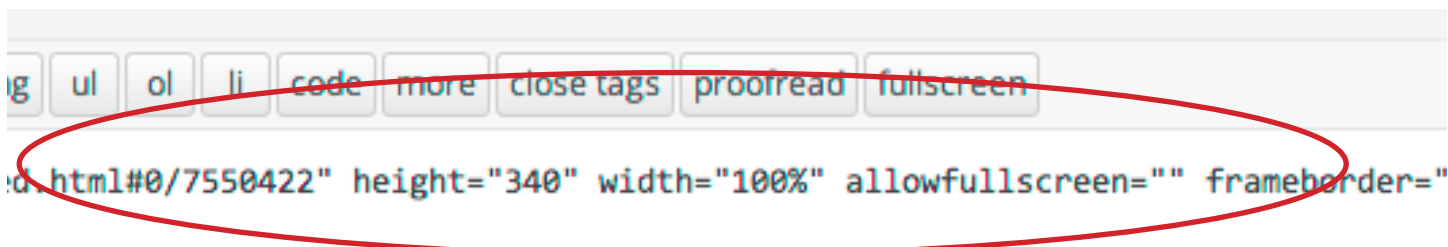
Navigate to your portfolio and in the text editor, make sure the “Text” tab is in front. Placing embed code in the “Visual” editor will NOT work.


Paste the issuu embed code in the text editor. You can include a description of the project.



**CORE MESSAGES**

- [TEAMWORK]** Teamwork is essential to success. Support each other and help each other out. Share your ideas and listen to others.
- [AUTHENTIC]** Don't copy. Be creative. Seek to demonstrate integrity in your work and attitude.
- [ACTIVE]** Be active in all things. Be a part of the team. Be a leader. Be a role model.
- [GROW]** Grow. Develop a sense of self-confidence. Don't seek to not only build your own skills but also those of your peers. Build on your own team's success.
- [SHARE]** Ownership of your academic progress. Become active learners not passive. Reflect on design decisions, and understand why you made them. Thoughtfully consider why your work is good or bad and encourage for discussion. Consider future feedback in order to improve your working methods, and make it moving forward.

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
