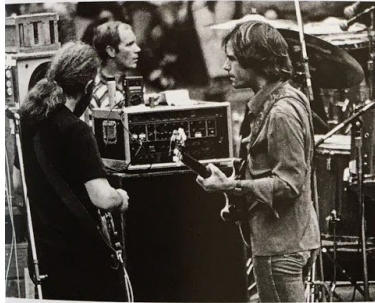


# **PART ONE: PLAYING IN THE BAND**









During the tour we met three Israelis who are staying at the youth hostel. At the end of the tour we all got sloshed on the free beer they give you.

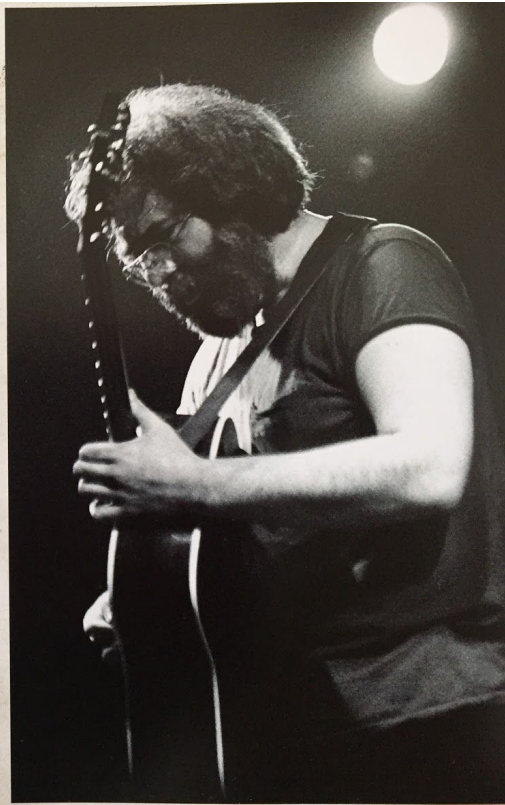
