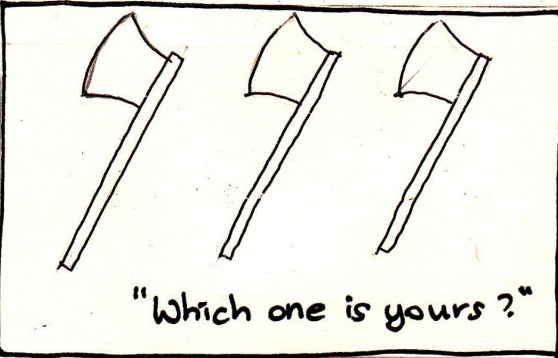
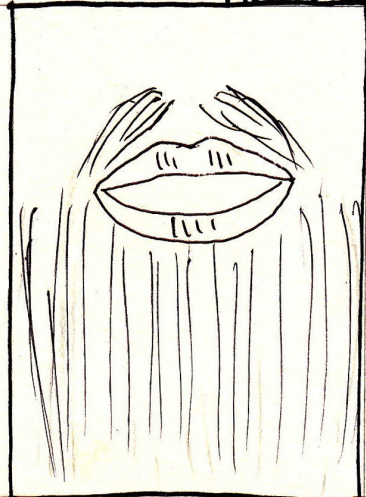
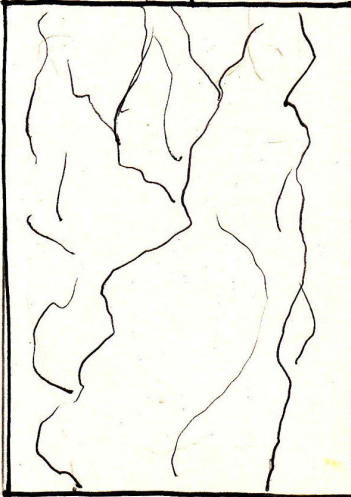
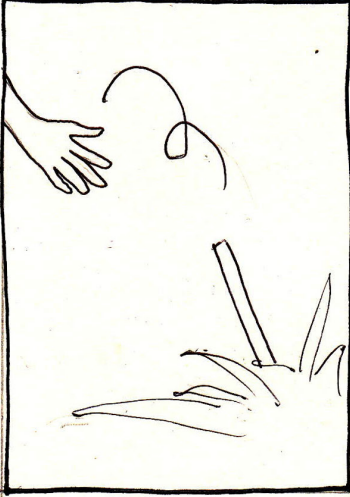
The honest lumberjack came back with the gold and silver axes. Soon, he became rich. And his mother became healthy.



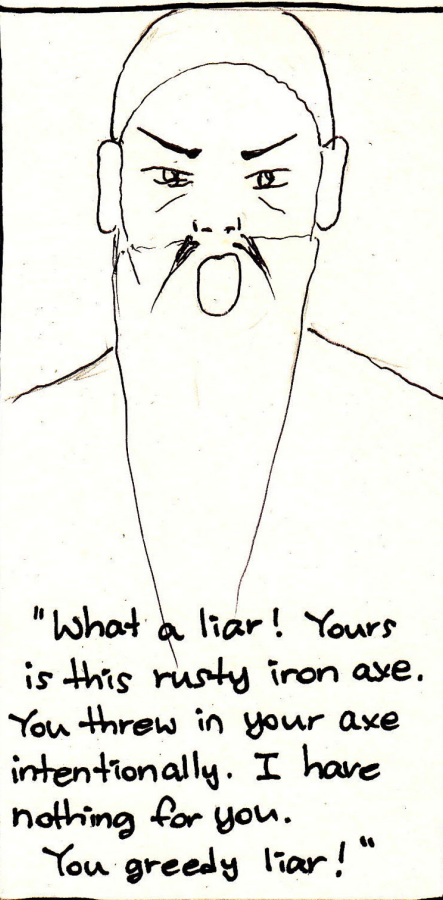
But, there was another lumberjack who saw the scene in the wood. The another lumberjack wanted gold and silver axes, too.
