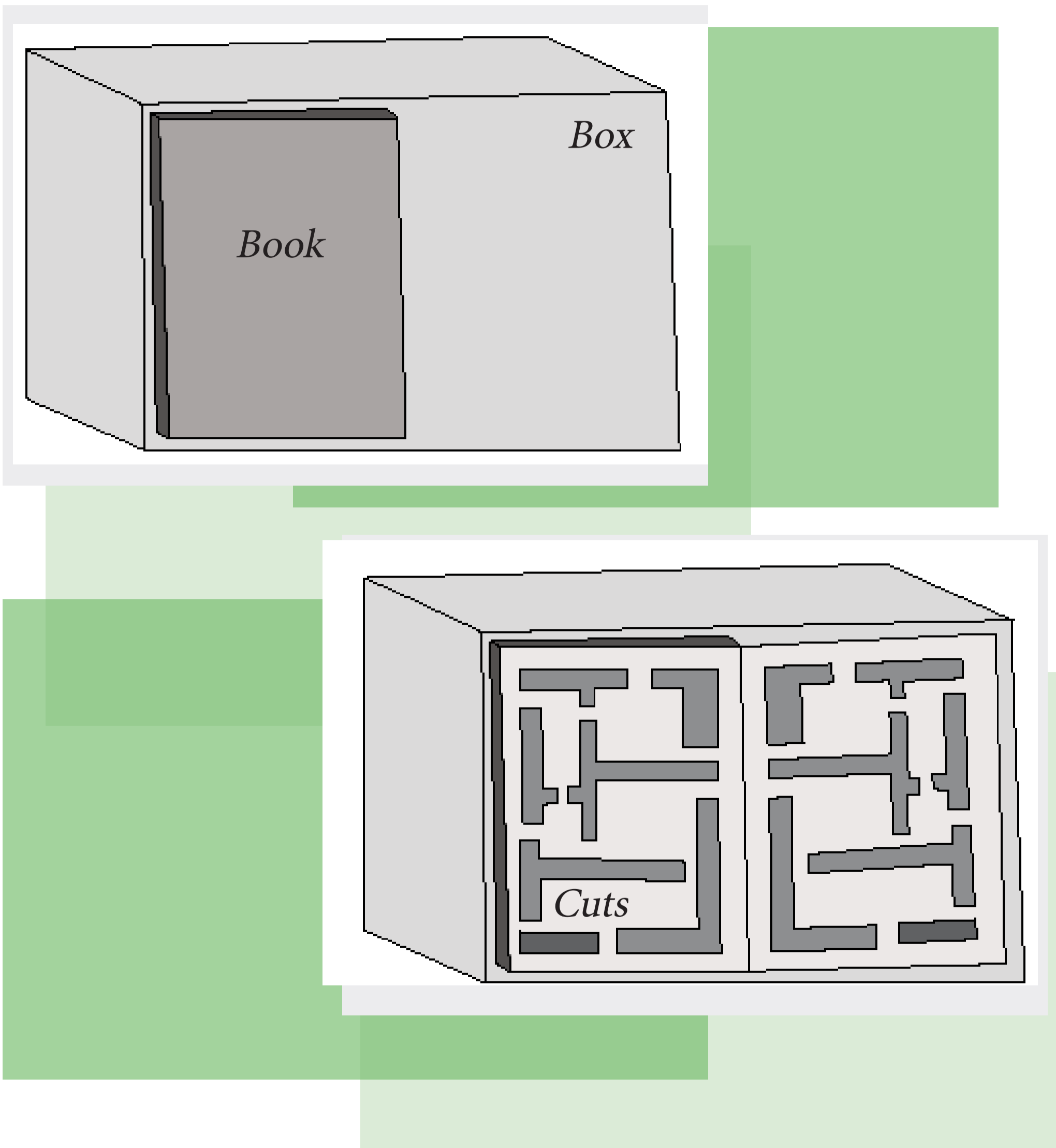




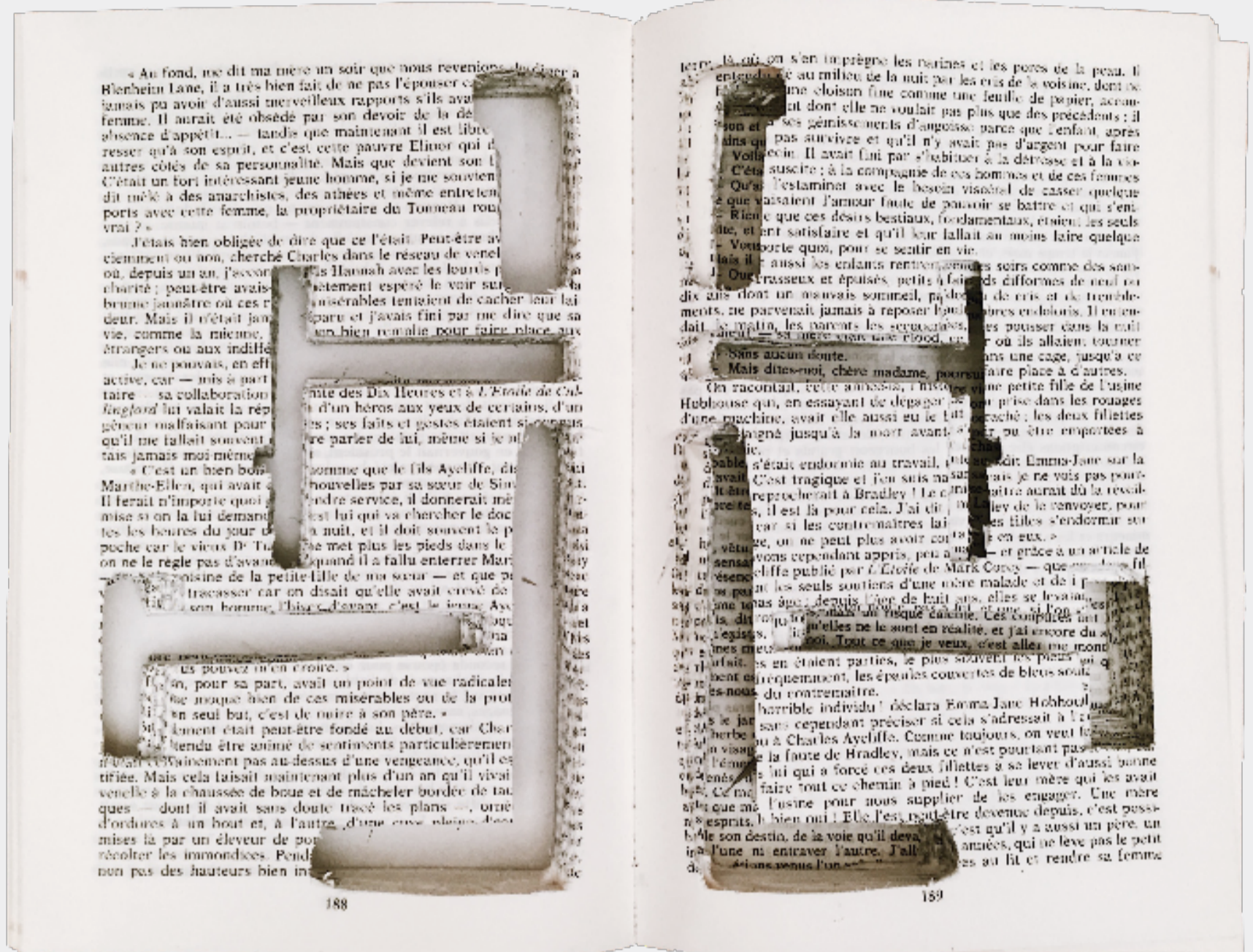


# PLANNING OF IDEA

# DEVELOPMENT OF IDEA



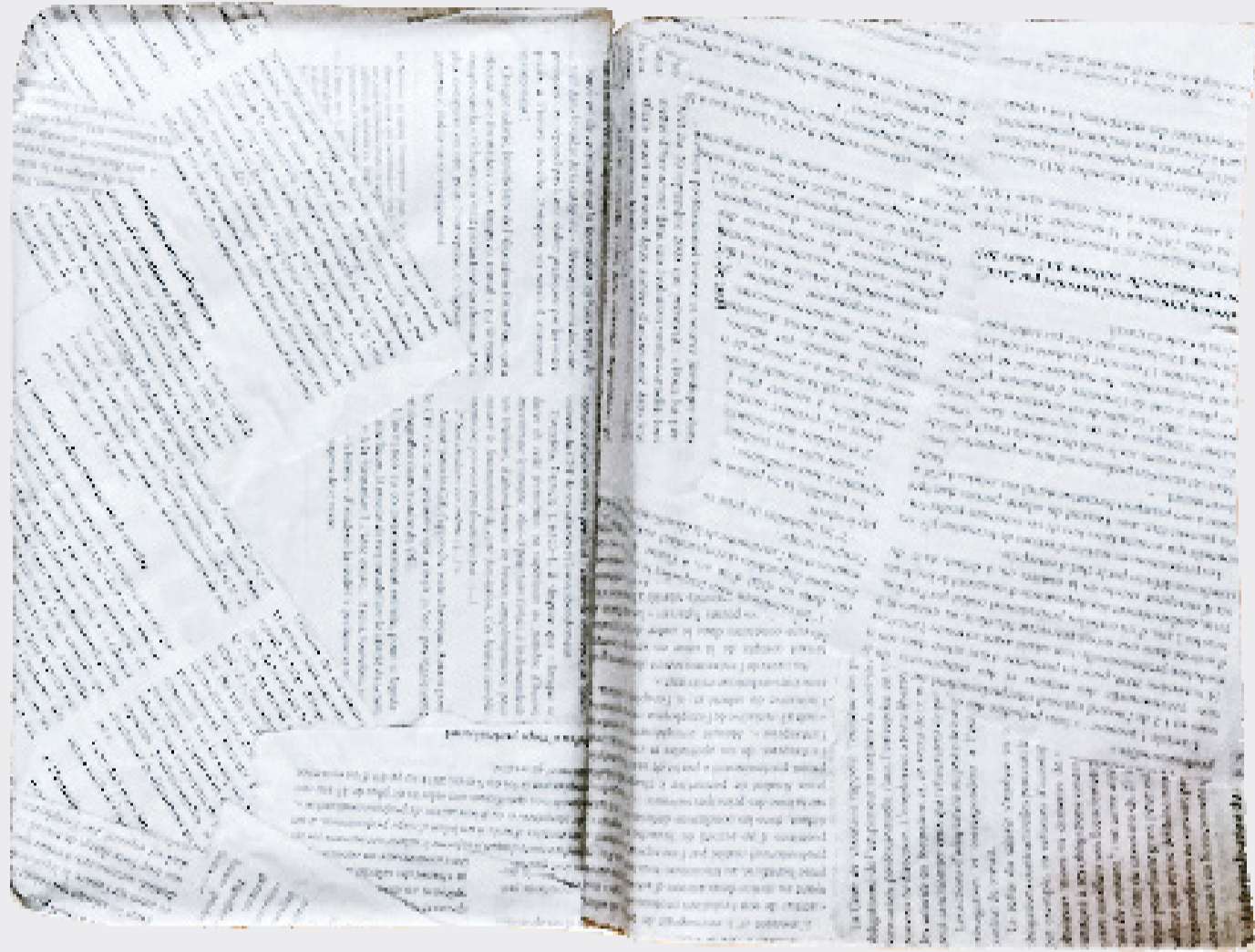
The layering pages of an A5 book were cut through the use of a cutting knife in a variety of geometric shapes, following the text within the book itself. These layers were not cut collectively, but 20 pages at a time in order not to severely damage them.

# FIRST ATTEMPT



The book was then placed on a cardboard box covered in layers of newspaper. The box was cut out on the top layer, right where the book was laying, in order for light underneath to shine directly through the book pages.
