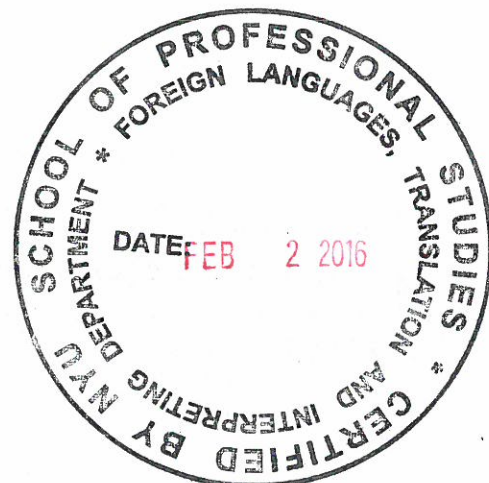
This is to inform you that on 11/3/2015, the Foreign Language Proficiency Testing Service of the New York University School of Professional Studies administered a test in Danish 12-Point Proficiency Exam to Sebastian Goetz (Student Identification Number ***-**-2566 ; NYU ID: N16905161).

Based on this two-hour examination of listening comprehension, free composition, and translation into and from the target language the examinee has attained a score of 12 out of a maximum of 12 points. The score is equivalent to up to 12 credits of college-level study. The score can also be used towards teacher certification in less commonly taught languages. The actual number of credits granted depends on the institution accepting the results.

The original of this letter bears the certification stamp of the department, and a copy is on file in the department. The results of these exams are valid for five years from the date when the exam was taken.
