

## DESCRIPTION

The Instructions Project is based on the concept of creating an art piece by only giving the instructions on howto do it and therefore giving the person creating it, a vaste amount of possibilities and interpretations.

The main inspiration for our Instruction Project was the book <u>Do It</u> by Bruce Altshuler (Author) and Hans Ulrich Obrist (Editor) that assembles a collection of instructions created by different artists.

Our take on the project is to give people instructions to create a non-cohesive story with sentences that follow a certain numeral order. The story has no boundary and every person can be as creative as they want to be while following the guidelines.

## INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Start with a group of three people
- Get a blank piece of paper and three different coloured markers
- 3. The first player writes a sentence containing the number '1' in a direct or subtle reference
- 4. Fold the part the paper with the sentence
- 5. The next player writes another sentence (without seeing the one before) that includes the number '2'
- 6. Repeat instructions n3-4-5 with an increasing number in every sentence
- 7. When you write the sentence for the number '10', unfold all the other sentences
- 8. Read the story you created !


# STORY NO.1
