History of NoHo

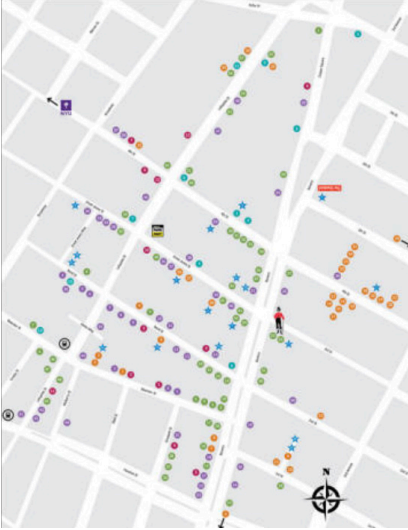
