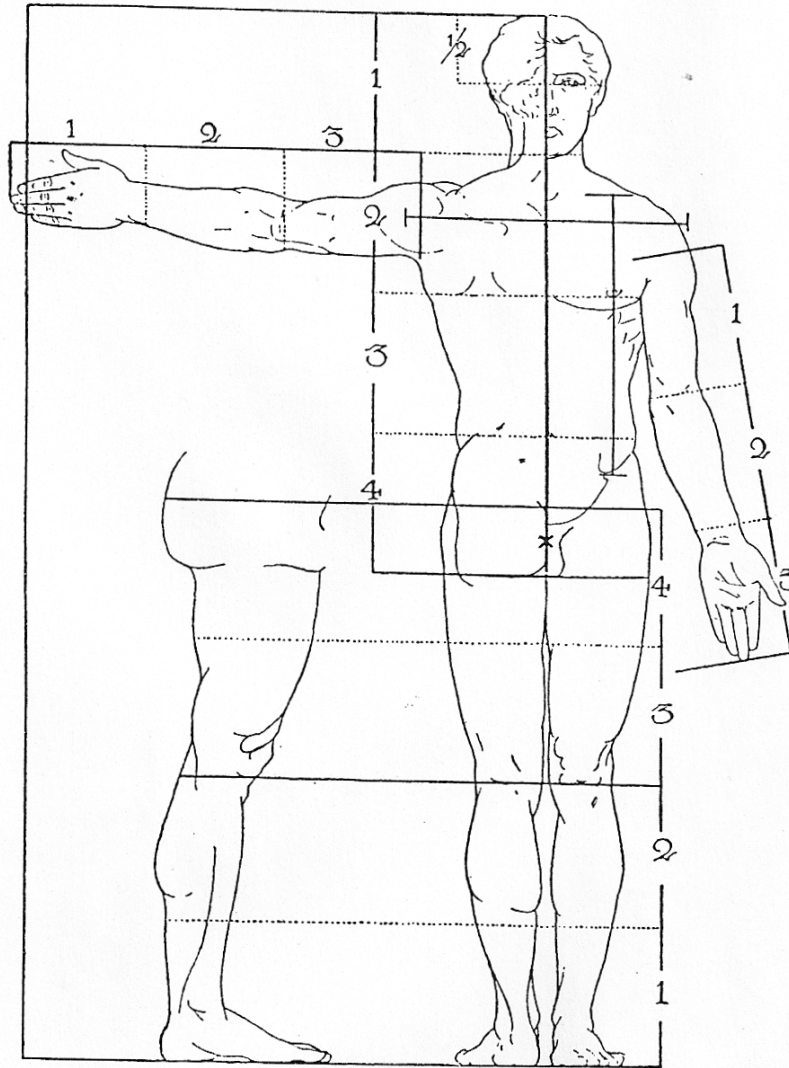
Subcutaneous Landmarks on the Human Body

- 7th Cervical Vertebrae
- Acromion Process
- Xiphoid Process
- Nipples (variable)

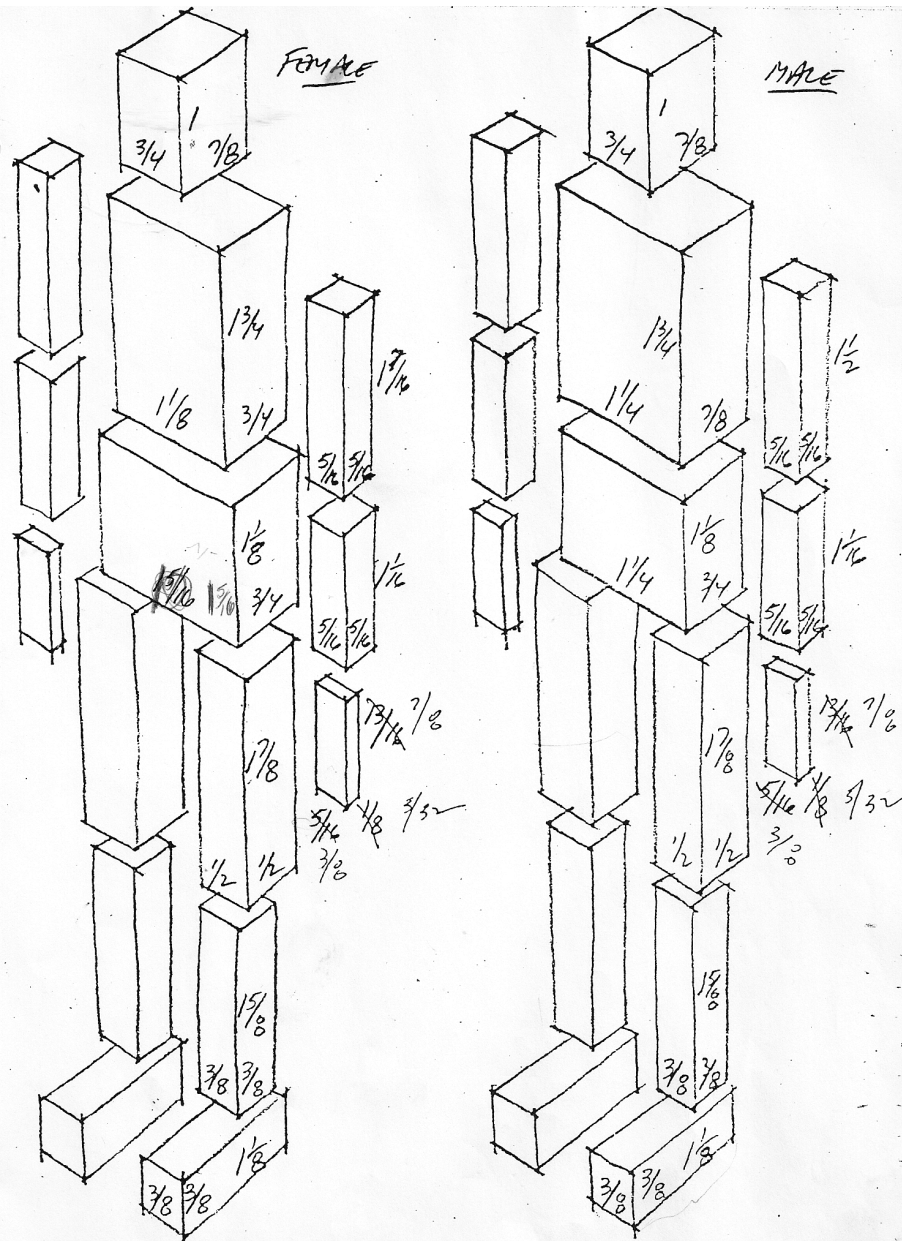
- Navel (variable)

The divisions indicate head-lengths. X marks the middle of the body. (From Richer.)



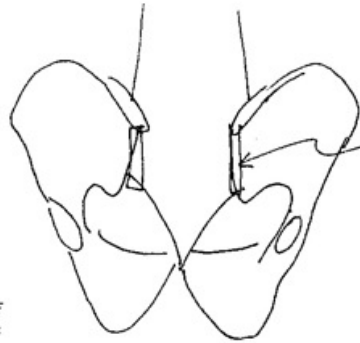
6) PROPORTIONS OF THE FIFTEEN BASIC RECTANGULAR VOLUMES



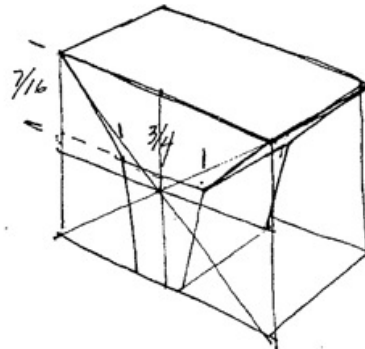
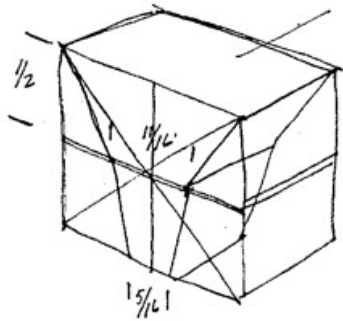
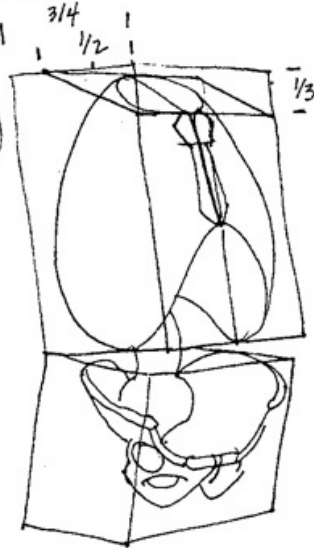

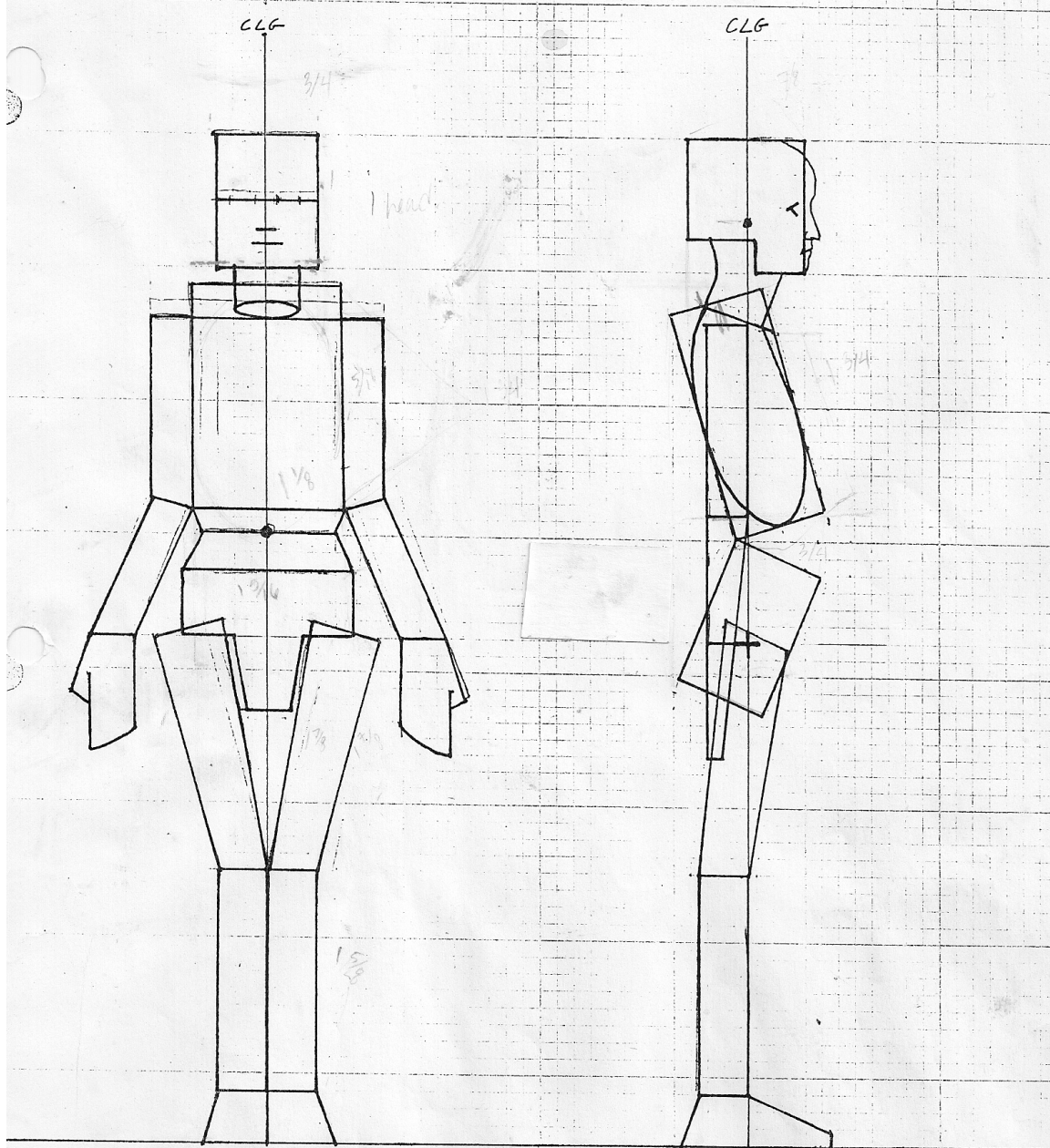

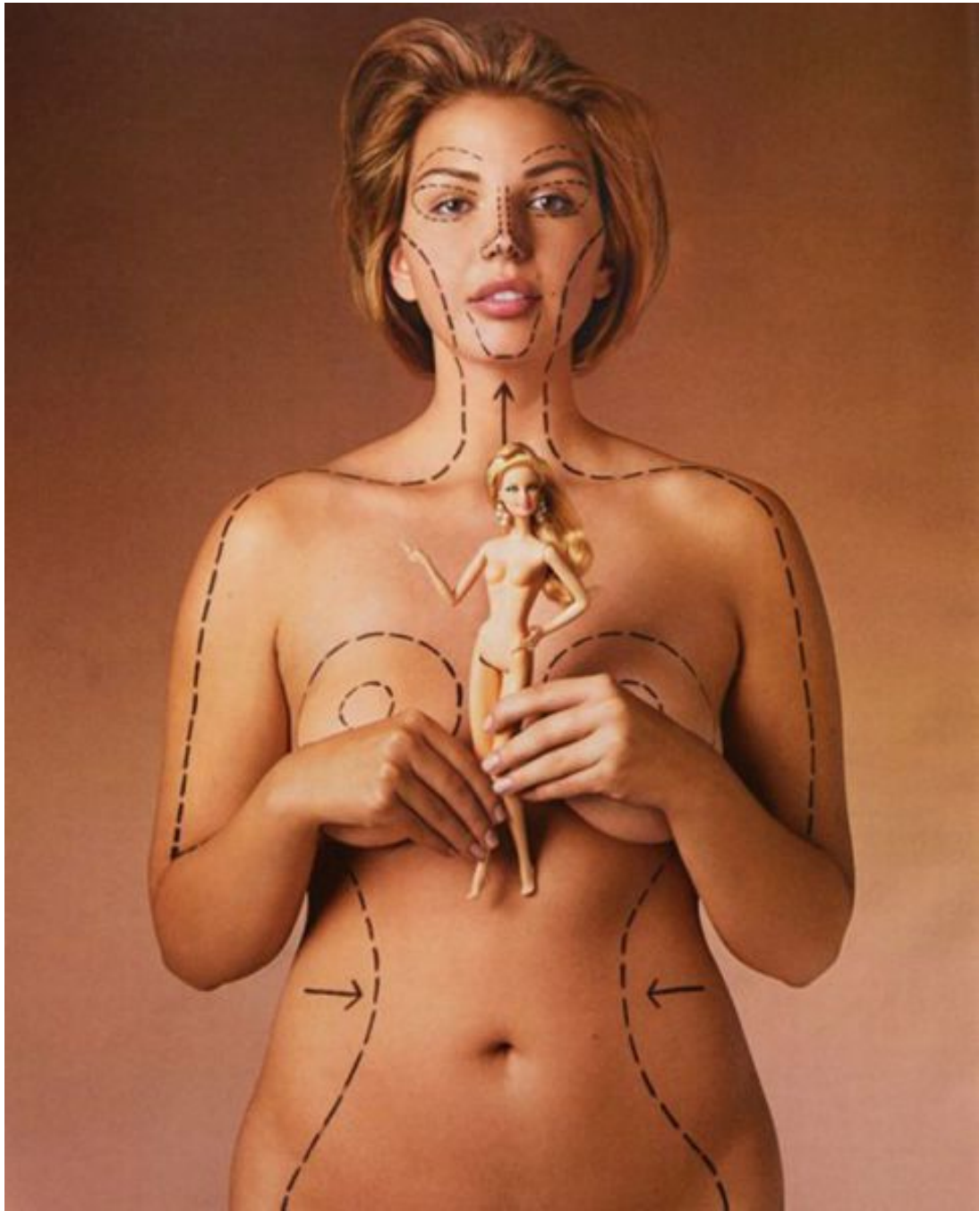
