Creative Project Statement

Movement: Pop and the Space Age

Movement Description: The movement presented a challenge to traditions of fine art by including imagery from popular and mass culture, such as advertising, comic books and mundane cultural objects. Common characteristics are bold colors and prints.

Movement: Art Nouveau
