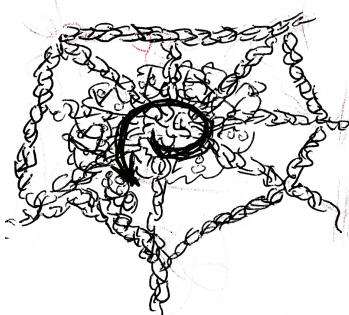
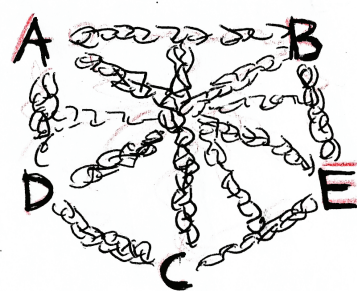
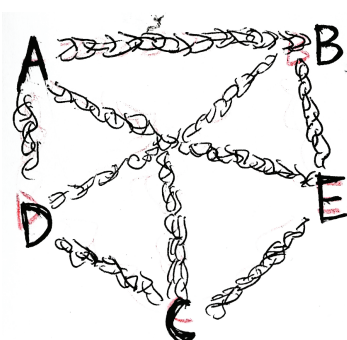
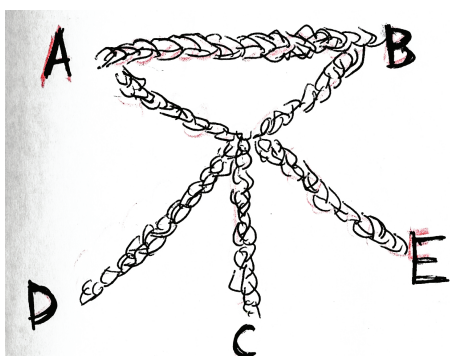
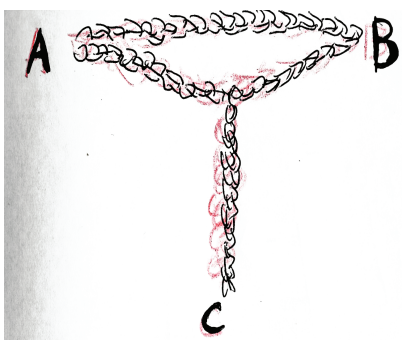
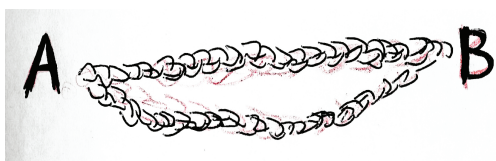


In order to make the structural threads, cut a single 4 gallon plastic trash bag into thirds. Tie the pieces together at one end and braid them together.

Repeat the process and connect the braids together to make a rope. Make at least 5 ropes.



To make the auxiliary thread, cut a 4 gallon plastic trashbag in half. Cut a piece of bubble wrap from the roll and cut the wrap into strips. The strips should be wider than the garbage bags. Tie the bags and wrap at one end and braid to create a rope.



When arranging the web, start with a structural strand connecting two points. Create a third point and make a looser thread connecting the original two points and connect another thread from the third point to the midpoint of the looser string. Attach new threads from the middle point to new structural points and attach new threads between the structural points. Wrap the auxiliary thread around the structural threads to make a complete web.
