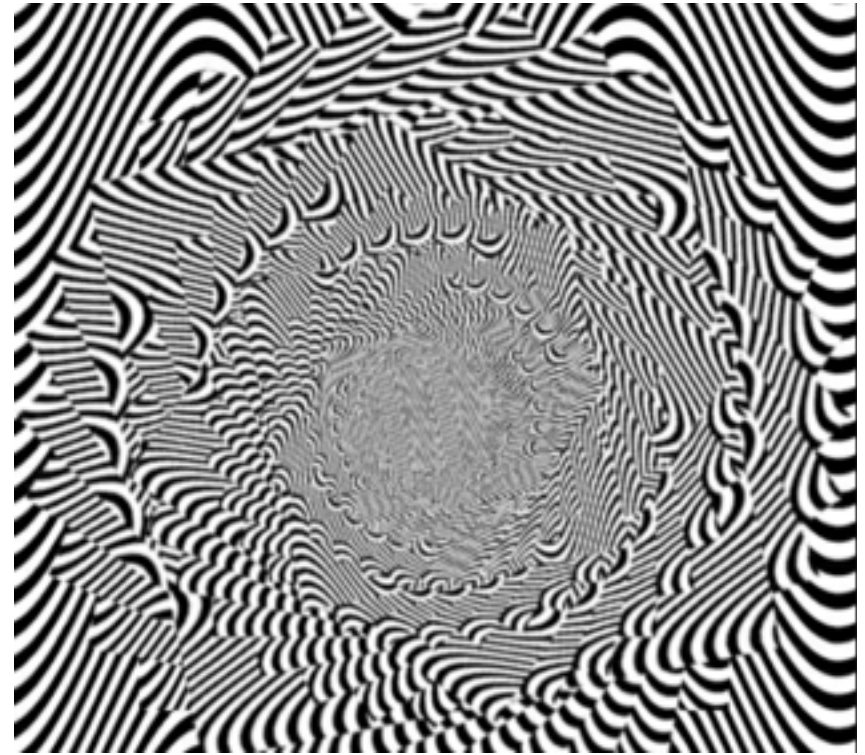
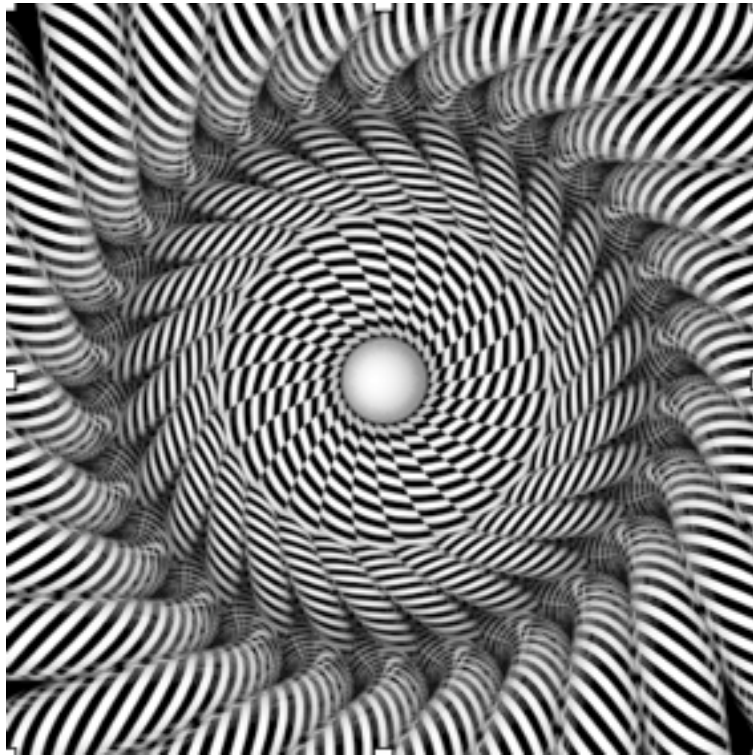


WHAT IS DRUG?

- Thiamine deficiency.

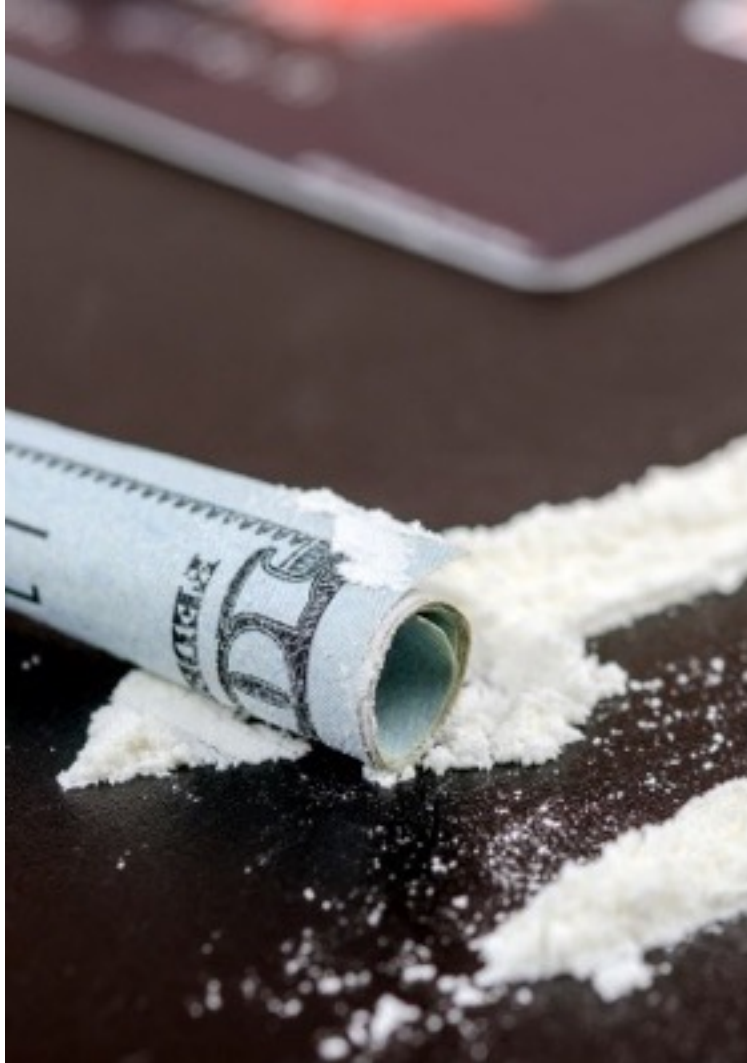


Also long term alcohol consumption could cause certain cancers, brain damage and immune system obstruction

Cocaine is also known as coke, and it is a highly addictive drug that usually comes in a powdery form. It is a stimulant that significantly speeds up all the processes in the body, especially the nervous system, making a person more energetic.

SHORT TERM EFFECTS OF COCAINE



- Intense euphoria
- Anxiety and paranoia
- Depression
- Intense drug craving
- Panic and psychosis
- Hallucinations
- Loss of appetite
- Increased heart rate, blood pressure, body temperature
- Contracted blood vessels
- Increased rate of breathing
- Dilated pupils
- Disturbed sleep patterns
- Nausea
- Hyper-stimulation

LONG TERM EFFECTS OF COCAINE



- Permanent damage to blood vessels of heart and brain
- High blood pressure, leading to heart attacks, strokes, and death
- Liver, kidney and lung damage
- Destruction of tissues in nose if sniffed
- Respiratory failure if smoked
- Infectious diseases and abscesses if injected
- Malnutrition, weight loss
- Irritability and mood disturbances
- Severe tooth decay
- Auditory and tactile hallucinations

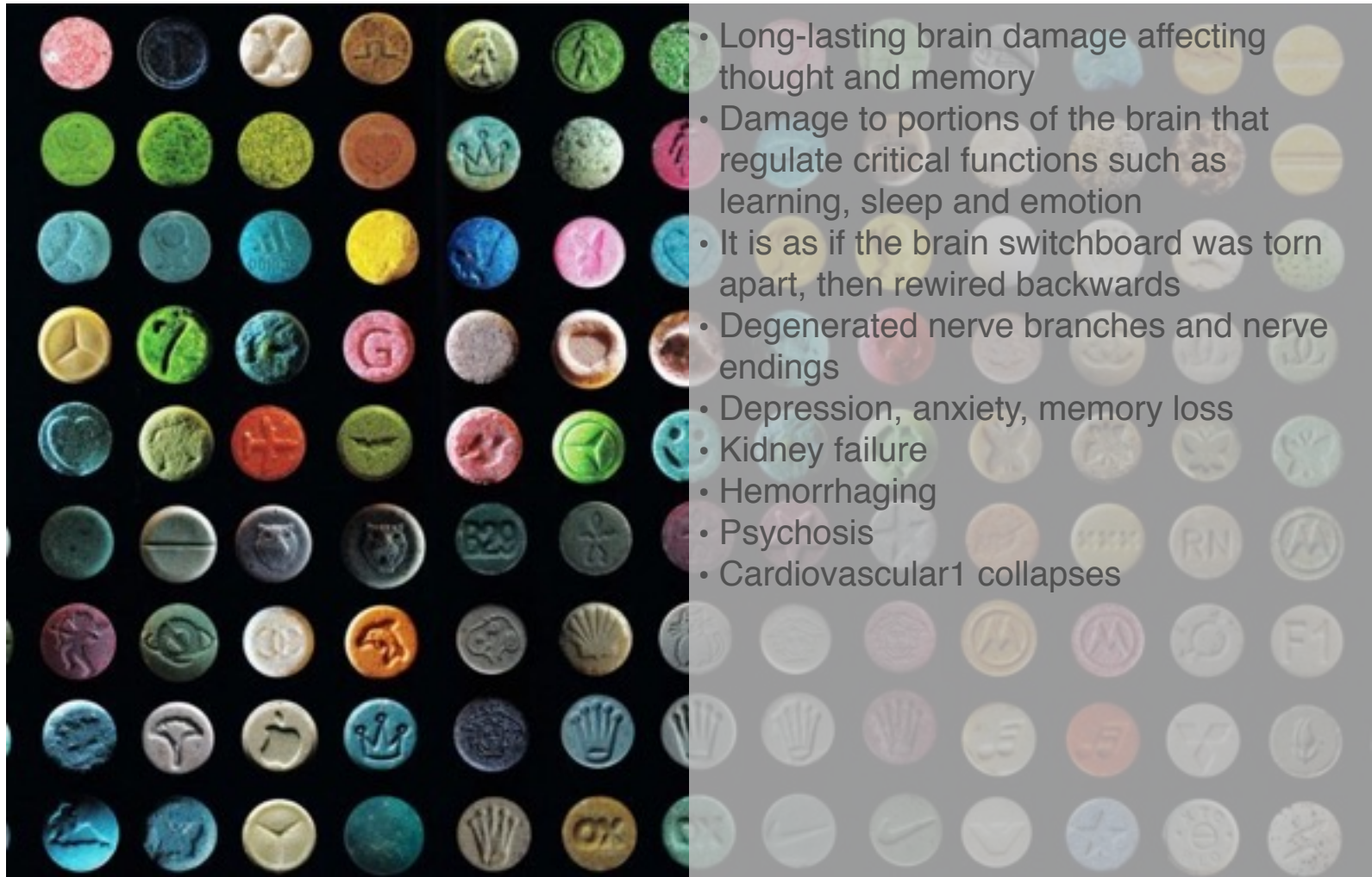

SHORT TERM EFFECTS OF MARIJUANA



- Short-term memory problems
- Severe anxiety, including fear that one is being watched or followed (paranoia)
- Very strange behavior, seeing, hearing or smelling things that aren't there, not being able to tell imagination from reality (psychosis)
- Panic
- Hallucinations
- Loss of sense of personal identity
- Lowered reaction time
- Increased heart rate (risk of heart attack)

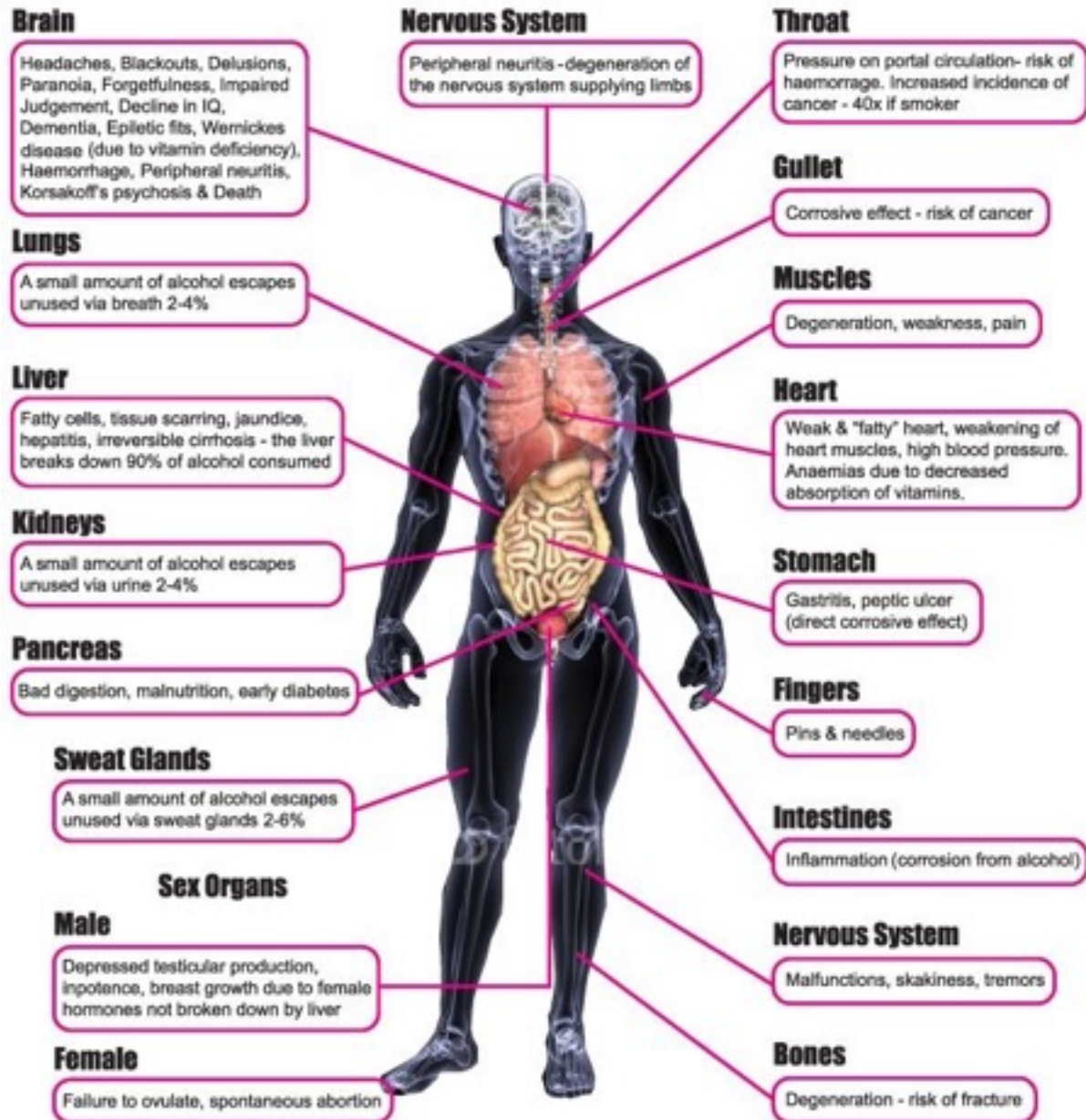




MENTHOL / FLAVORED (POPS)

DRUG REHABILITATION CENTERS

INPATIENT TREATMENT



Inpatient treatment is more intensive than outpatients. It focuses more on medical treatment and requires the patient to stay at the center during the length of the program that they entered. Patients who decided to receive inpatient treatments often need more dedication to get off drugs as they are more controlled than outpatient patients.

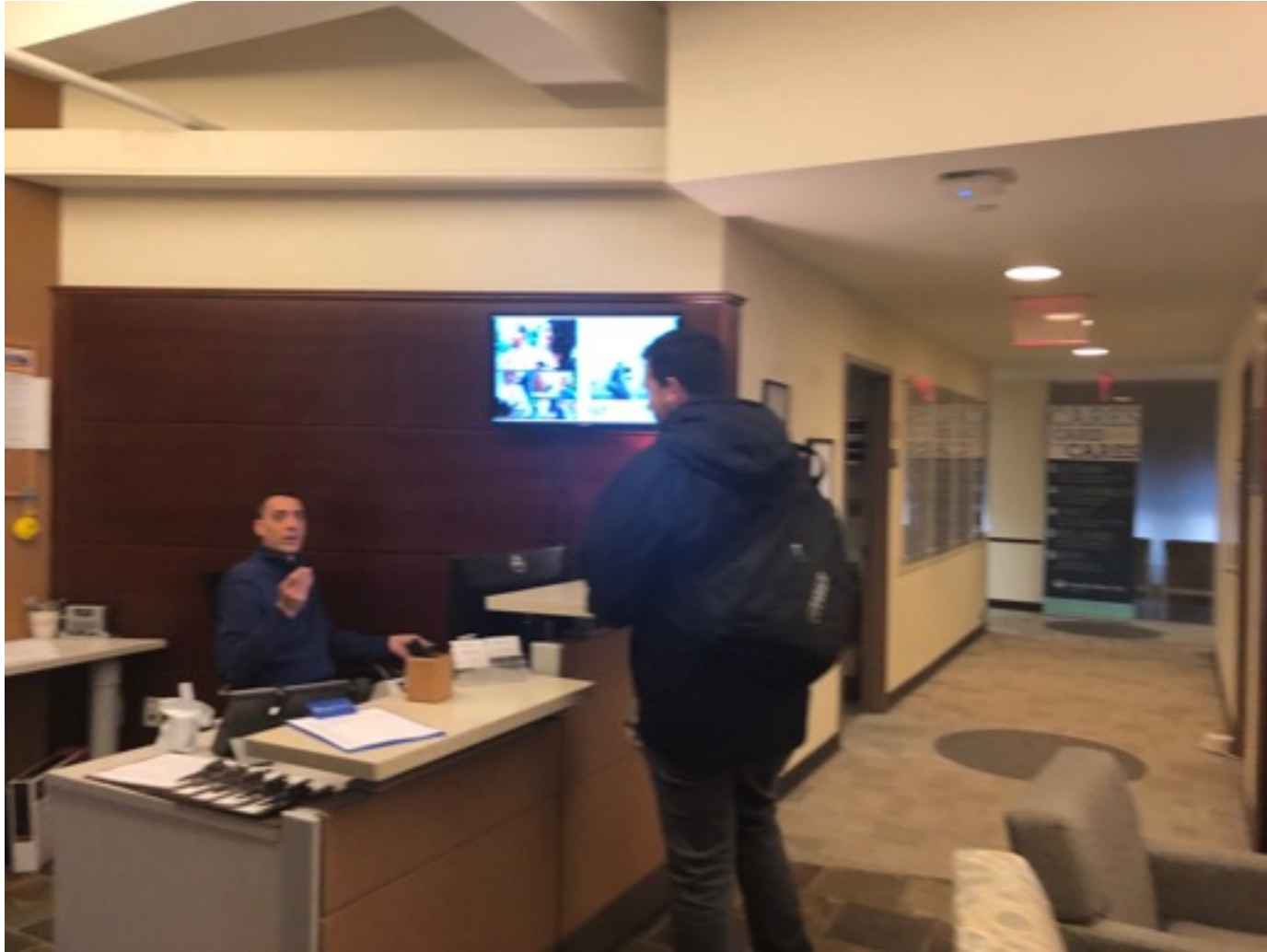

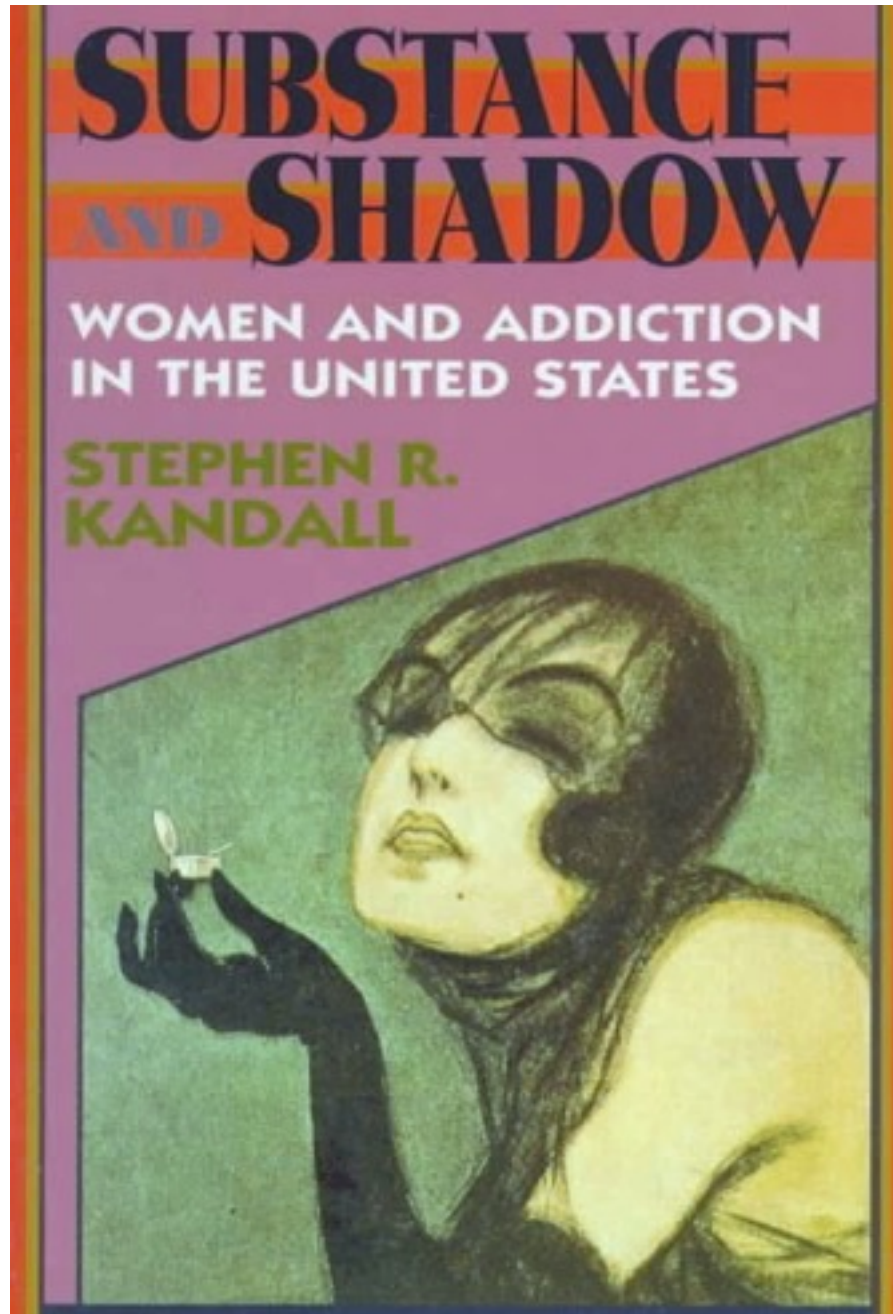

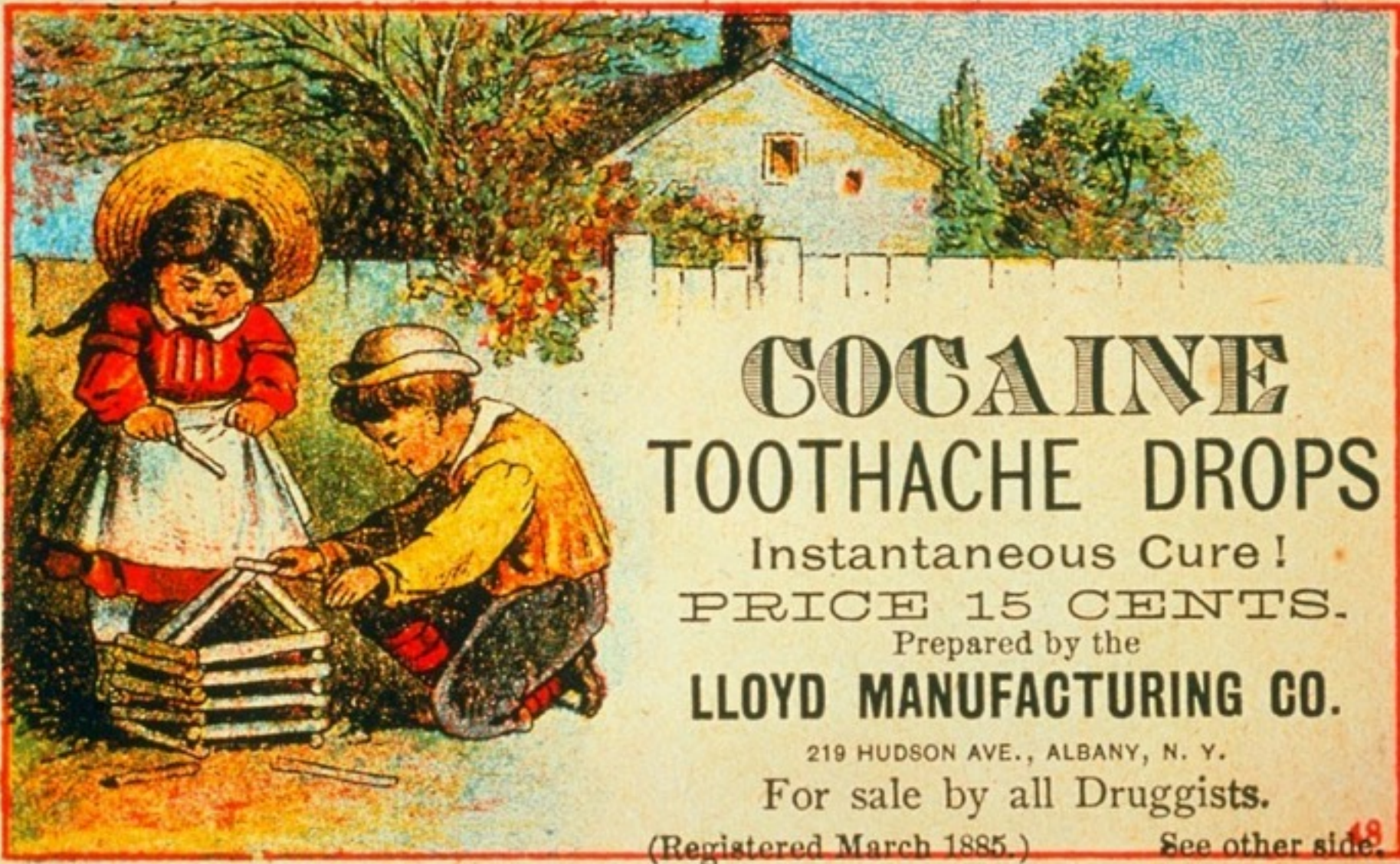
