




### MEXT ROOM

This was Bastille on the same day in the year 1789, 232 years ago.




#### THIS IS WHAT HAPPENED ...


The people in the city did not have money to buy bread, so they decided to protest. On the 14th of July 1789, they burned down Bastille (which at the time was a prison) in order to get arms.
